

RoHS declaration of conformity

The use of hazardous substances in equipment and components is regulated by the European Directive 2011/65/EU and 2015/863/EU.

These directives currently allow exemptions from the restrictions of lead, for use as an alloy element in copper, aluminium and steel.

Following exceptions are applied:

- 6a: Lead as an alloying element in steel for machining purposes and in galvanized steel containing up to 0.35 % lead by weight
- 6b: Lead as an alloying element in aluminium containing up to 0.4% lead by weight
- 6c: Copper alloy containing up to 4% lead by weight

We hereby declare that all products delivered to you have been produced in compliance with the RoHS directive 2015/863/EU.
